QUICK SUMMARY OF INVESTMENTS

As you know, we have chosen to finance our renovation project through the Presbyterian Investment & Loan Program, a non-profit agency of the PC(USA).

Monies borrowed through the Program that will fund our project came from Presbyterians like you. Now you have the opportunity to support another church project just like this one, at the same time as helping our congregation reduce the amount of money we pay in interest on this loan. One of the ways that the Program raises funds to lend to churches is by selling interest-bearing Term Notes. This is an investment that returns interest to you, the individual – it is not a gift or an endowment. Moreover, as the amount invested by our members increases to certain levels, the Investment & Loan Program will reduce the cost of our church's mortgage through an annual rebate. The rebate can reduce the interest paid on our loan by as much as one full percentage point.

The minimum investment is only \$500, and you can choose how long you want to invest – as short as six months up to five years. At the end of the term you chose, you can reinvest or withdraw your money. This is an investment – not a gift. For many of us, this is not "new" money but rather moving a few funds from other investments like savings, money market accounts or CDs into the Program's Term Notes.
