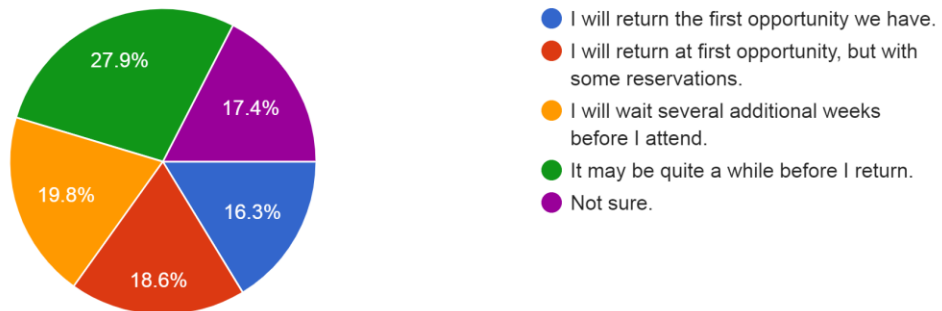


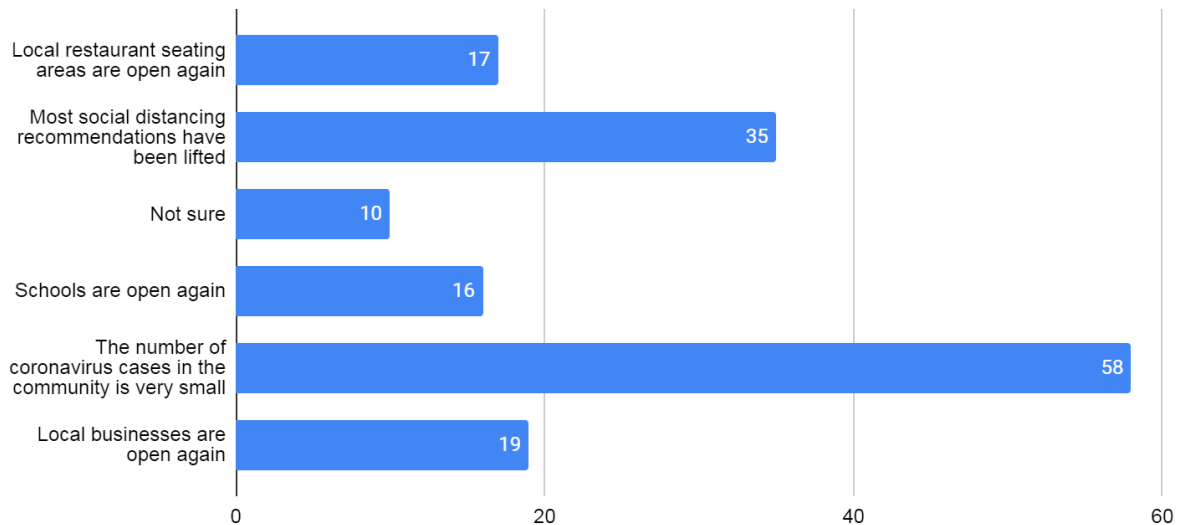
## Central Presbyterian Church Return to Worship Survey Results (86 Total Responses)

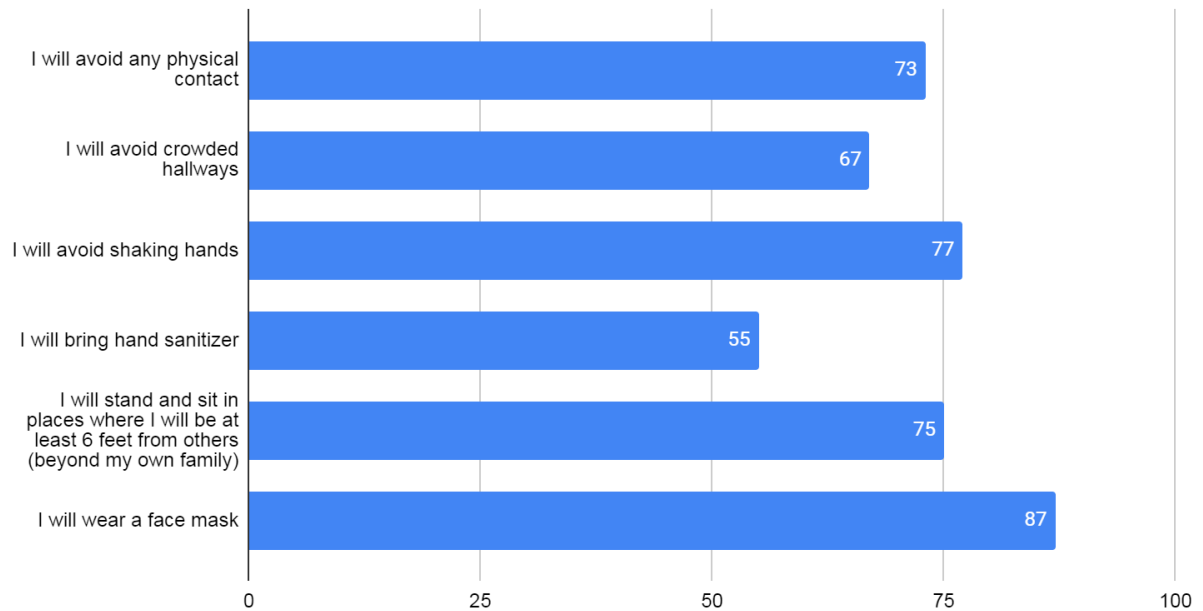
In addition to our local government lifting its ban or guidance against public gatherings are there other signals you would want to see before you return to attend a worship service at church? Select all that apply:

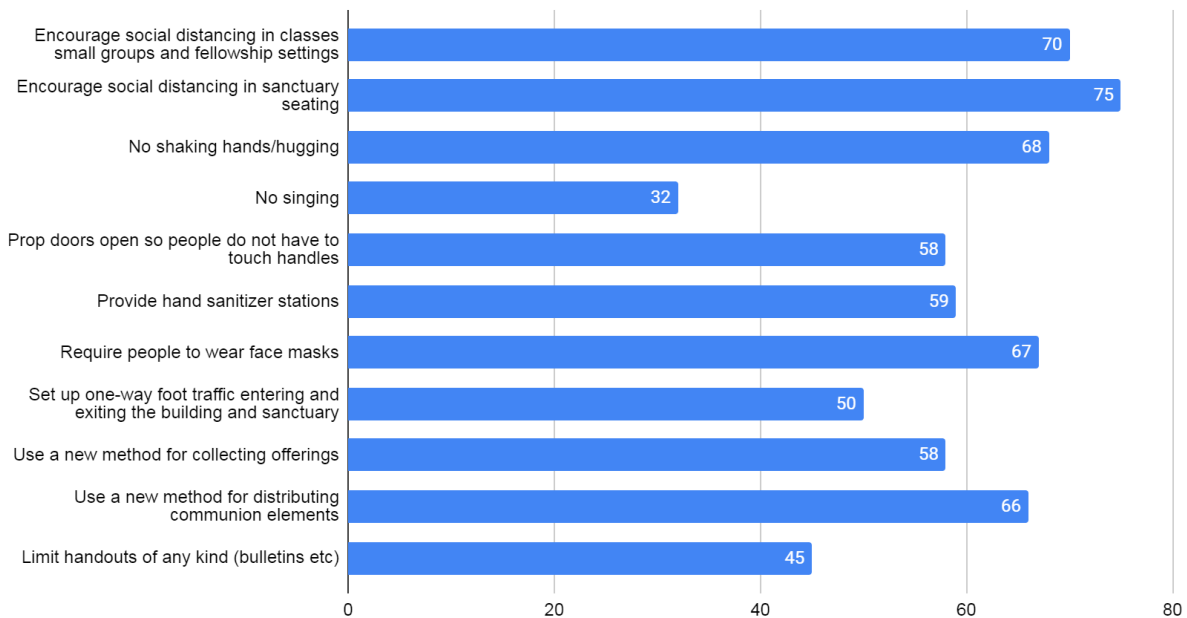

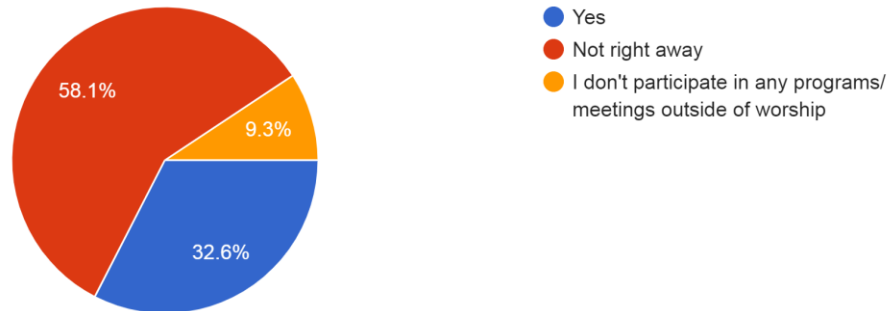
What precautions do you expect our church to take to protect worshipers during all gatherings of our community? Select all that apply:

Continue virtual service until there's an all clear

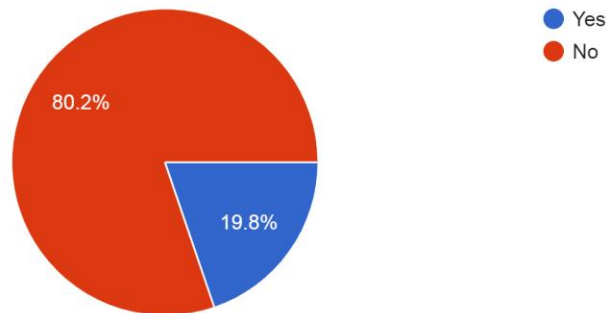

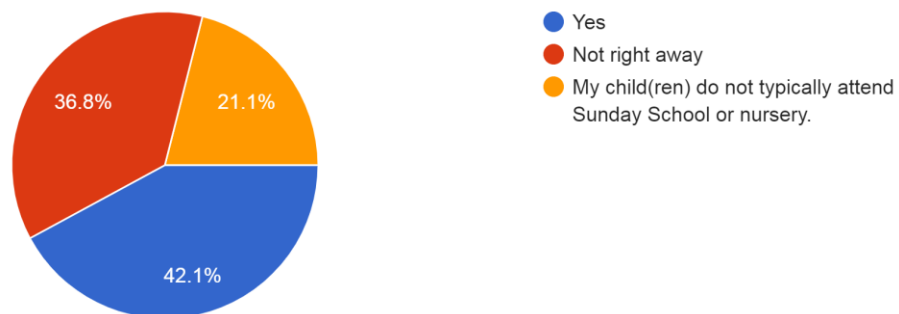
6. Do you have children age 18 or younger who live with you and typically attend church with you?

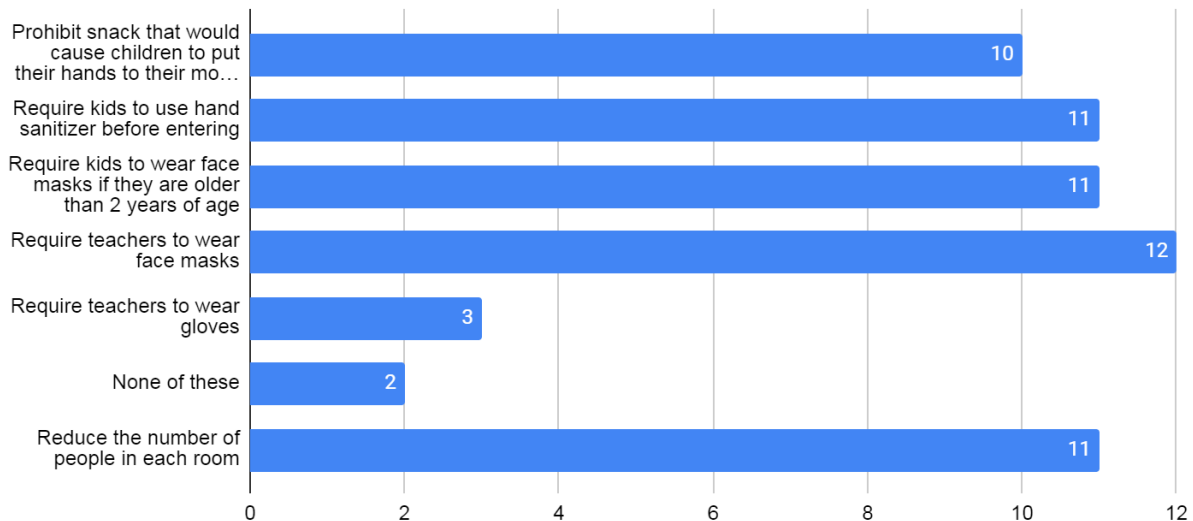

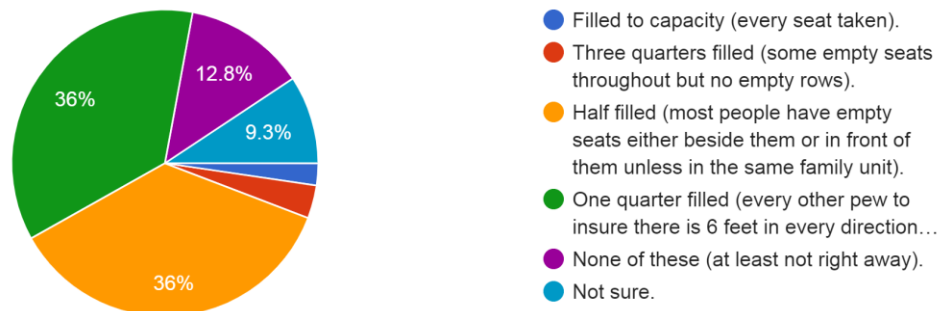
If answered yes to question six: What precautions if any do you expect the church to take in youth programming when they resume? Select all that apply:

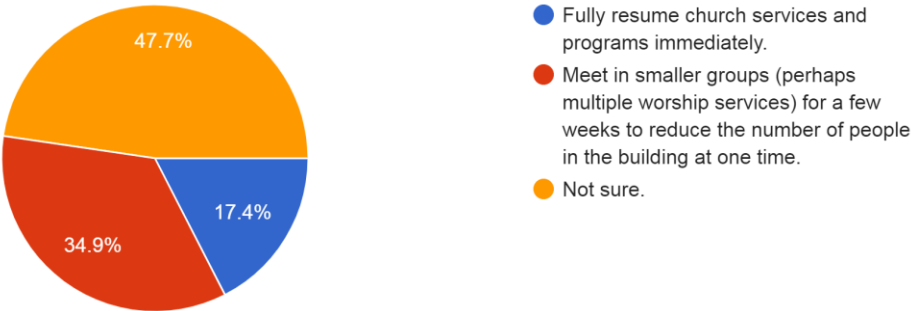
9. Which of the following describes the attendance level at which you would be comfortable attending a worship service? I would be comfortable attending if the sanctuary is...

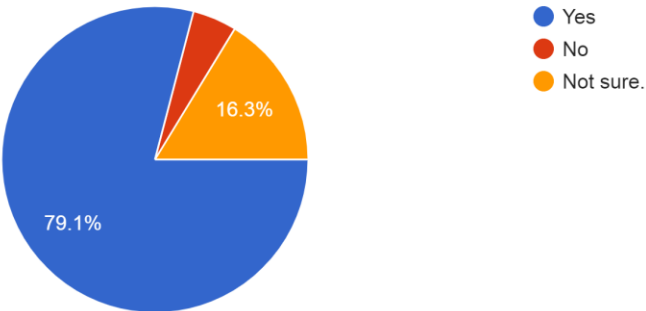
10. When we begin in person worship and church events again, which of the following would you prefer for our church?

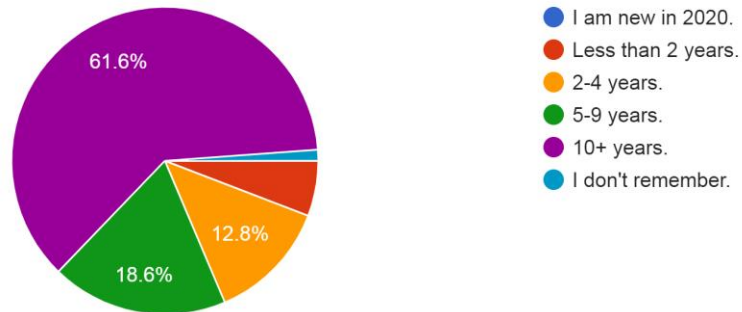
11. Would you be willing to attend a worship service at a different time than you typically attend in order to allow people to spread out in the sanctuary?

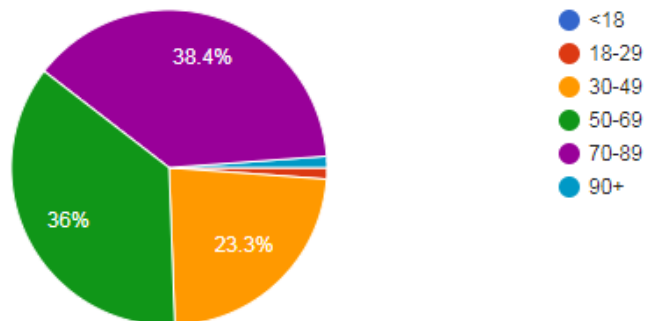
### 12. How long have you been attending?
